Children Protection – Information for Parents and Carers

*Every child has the right to be protected.
It is everyone's responsibility to protect children.*

Most children are subject to minor accidental injuries, but there may be occasions when you are concerned about the nature or frequency of injury. Parents should be aware that you are obliged to inform Children's Services/Hampshire Safeguarding Children Partnership, of any concern you may have that a child may be at risk or abused. The safety of children may include a duty to share confidential information with others involved in protecting children. It is important to avoid any unnecessary delay.
